- ❖ **Goal:** The primary goal of the ICMR: GCLP guideline is to ensure the reliability, accuracy and integrity of data generated by all medical laboratories involved in patient care and clinical research in India.
- ❖ **Equipment & Facilities available:** State of Art technology equipped NABL accredited Lab, (in-house training) in hybrid mode with 2 contact session 1 day each for external student.
- ❖ **Duration of Course:** 12 Weeks
- ❖ **Eligibility:** Post Graduates (PG) of Biochemistry, Microbiology, Pathology, Molecular Biology.

- ❖ **Course Content (Curriculum):** ICMR guidelines for Good Clinical Laboratory Practices (GCLP-2021) aims to establish minimum criteria to be followed by clinical and research laboratory in involved in examination human sample, in routine healthcare delivery and clinical research, The intent of GCLP guidelines is that when laboratories adhere to this process, it ensures quality and integrity of data, allows accurate reconstruction of experiments, monitors data quality and allows comparison of test results regardless of performance location, It is mandatory for all postgraduate student to have a certified in GCLP before appearing final exam as per NMC.

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
