Patients with serious ailments were then referred to SAIMS Hospital for further management.

Case Report 1

MINIMALLY INVASIVE ENDOSCOPIC EXCISION OF THIRD VENTRICULAR COLLOID CYST

A Thirty Nine year old female resident of Sanwer came with complaints of Headache since 3 months, Giddiness since 1 and half month

History of present illness :- Headache since 3 months , holocranial, intermittent, relieved by medication and lying down position.

Headache more in morning associated with vomiting and gets relieved after vomiting.

Giddiness since one and half month. Present in walking . Relieved with rest and medication.

No complaints of visual disturbances.

No complaints of weakness of limbs , bowel and bladder irregularities

Clinical examination :- vitals- stable

Oriented to time place and person.

Cranial nerve examination –normal

Motor and sensory examination- normal

Autonomic examination- normal

Mri :- 1.5*1.3*1 cm oval intra ventricular sol present in third ventricle .T1 – Hyperintense , T2- isointense. Peripheral contrast enhancing . Moderate hydrocephalus with dilatation of lateral and third ventricles.

Surgery :- Patient taken under General anaesthesia , supine position . Burr hole made in rt kocher point .

Ventricular puncture done . Rigid ventriculoscope introduced . Third ventricle entered . Tumor dissected and excised, done in piece meal manner. External ventricular drain inserted.

Histopathology :- MICROSCOPIC : The section show bits of mucoid eosinophilic acellular material. No other tissue element or cell identified in section studied.

IMPRESSION: Colloid cyst .

Post op ct :- No evidence of Hydrocephalus. Minimal pneumocephalus seen along left anterior frontal convexity. No residual lesion noted.

Post op period was uneventful . Patient was relieved of headache and giddiness .

Patient was discharged with oral medication and is on regular follow up.

Discussion :-

A colloid cyst is a non-malignant tumor in the brain. It consists of a gelatinous material contained within a membrane of epithelial tissue. It is almost always found just posterior to the foramen of Monro in the anterior aspect of the third ventricle, originating from the roof of the ventricle. Because of its location, it can cause obstructive hydrocephalus and increased intracranial pressure. Colloid cysts represent 0.5–1.0% of intracranial tumors. Patients with third-ventricular colloid cysts become symptomatic when the tumor enlarges rapidly, causing cerebrospinal fluid (CSF) obstruction, ventriculomegaly, and increased intracranial pressure. Some cysts enlarge more gradually, however, allowing the patient to accommodate the enlarging mass without disruption of CSF flow, and the patient remains asymptomatic. There are various management options depending on the severity of symptoms and their effects on the patient. The main management options are observation, craniotomy for microsurgical resection, neuroendoscopic removal, stereotactic drainage, and CSF diversion with bilateral ventriculoperitoneal shunting placement.

NON-SURGICAL MANAGEMENT OF CLASS III INVASIVE CERVICAL RESORPTION: A case report.

CASE HISTORY: A 25-year-old male patient reported to the Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics with the chief complaint of bleeding gums and mild pain in maxillary right front tooth region since few months. Patient had a history of trauma due to fall to maxillary anterior tooth region 5-6 year ago. On clinical examination, cervical region of maxillary canine revealed a cavitated lesion (Figure:1) and increased probing depth (>6mm). IOPA revealed a radiolucency located on mesial side of maxillary right canine (Figure:2). To understand the specific anatomical knowledge in details, patient was referred for CBCT analysis.

DIAGNOSIS: The axial sections of CBCT revealed the entry point of granulation tissue to be located in cervical region (Figure:3). The sagittal CBCT slice showed irregular canal morphology with scattered radiolucency indicative of Invasive Cervical Resorption (ICR) (Figure:4). An invasive resorptive lesion was evident close to the cervical area with dentinal penetration and pulp involvement, which helped to establish the clinical classification of ICR Class III (Heithersay's GS classification)

MANAGEMENT: Following patient consent, endodontic treatment with the Maxillary right canine was initiated. The working length was determined (Figure:5), and canal was cleaned & shaped using rotary files (NeoEndo) to file size of no. 30/06 and calcium hydroxide dressing was given for 7 days (Figure:6). On the second visit, calcium hydroxide was removed canal was dried with paper points and a gutta-percha (#30/0.06) was placed in canal to maintain its patency (Figure:7), during the restoration process. Granulomatous tissue was excavated from the resorptive area using hand excavators. The cavity was treated with 90% aqueous solution of trichloroacetic acid the cavity was dried, and the resorptive area was filled with glass-ionomer cement (Figure:8).

CONCLUSION: The patient was re-evaluated on a regular basis. The teeth were asymptomatic with no periodontal pockets circumferentially. Long term recall showed satisfactory gingival healing. Six-month follow-up of the case did not reveal any recurrence.



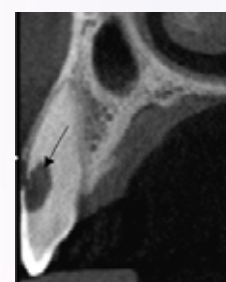
1. a cavitated lesion at cervical region of right maxillary canine.
