HSICON 2024 Pre-Course Kicks Off at IRCAD India, SAU Campus



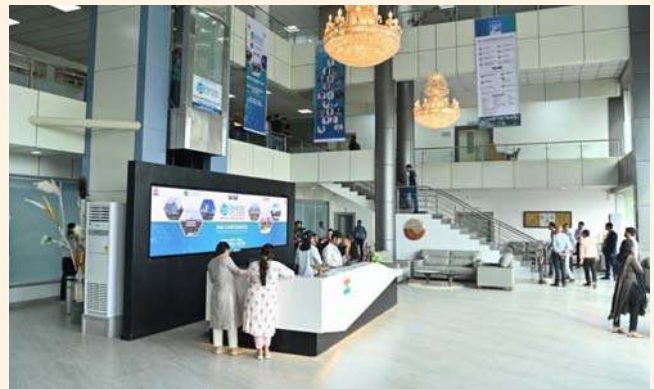

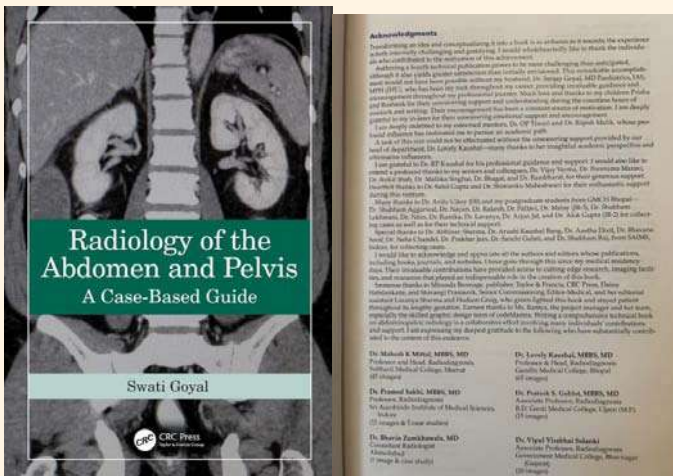


PCOS Workshop at Sri Aurobindo University
