

श्री अरबिंदो हॉस्पिटल रतलाम में ०६ घंटे में हुई 13 सफल लेप्रोस्कोपिक सर्जरियां

रतलाम। प्रदेश के प्रतिष्ठित अस्पताल एवं शिक्षण समूह श्री अरबिंदो समूह द्वारा संचालित जैन दिवाकर श्री अरबिंदो हॉस्पिटल, रतलाम में एक बार फिर लेप्रोस्कोपिक सर्जरी का नया कीर्तिमान बनाया गया। विश्वविख्यात रोबोटिक और लेप्रोस्कोपिक सर्जन डॉ महक भंडारी द्वारा 06 घंटे से भी कम समय में एक के बाद एक पुरे 13 मरीजों की सफल सर्जरियां रतलाम में ही की गर्यी। सभी मरीज स्वस्थ हैं और फिलहाल अस्पताल में ही स्वास्थ्य लाभ ले रहे हैं। इसके पूर्व भी डॉ महक भंडारी द्वारा रतलाम में ही 03 घंटे में 07 मरीजों की लेप्रोस्कोपिक सर्जरी की जा चुकी हैं। ज्ञात हो कि डॉ महक भंडारी प्रत्येक सप्ताह अरबिंदो हॉस्पिटल रतलाम में आकर आधुनिक तकनीकों से लेप्रोस्कोपिक सर्जरी करते हैं। डॉ भंडारी द्वारा रतलाम में विगत 04 माह में ही 111 मरीजों की सफलतम लेप्रोस्कोपिक सर्जरियां की जा चुकी हैं। दूरबीन पद्गति से की गई इन सर्जरियों में इनगुइनल हर्निया, अम्ब्लाइकल हर्निया, गॉलब्लेडर, अपेंडिक्स और हाइटस हर्निया आदि जैसी अत्यंत जटिल सर्जरी भी शामिल थीं।

This advanced laboratory offers precise chromosomal analysis through karyotyping and FISH, addressing critical needs in oncogenetics, reproductive medicine, and fetal medicine. Initial services include couple screening, prenatal screening (chromosomes 13, 18, 21, and X/Y), HER2 detection, and BCR-ABL fusion detection, with plans for future expansion. We are dedicated to advancing diagnostic excellence, enhancing patient care, and achieving improved treatment outcomes.

Dr Nithin Santosh, Asst Professor worked wonderfully as Organising secretary and the event was a huge success.


















It is our great pleasure to inform you that we have achieved another milestone in in introducing IV Dobutamine Stress Myocardial perfusion imaging in Coronary Artery Disease in one of our patient who can not walk on normal treadmill exercise and there is a known history of bronchial asthma for which we are unable to do IV Adenosine Myocardial perfusion imaging study which we do routinely.


IV Dobutamine is a positive ionotropic as well as chronotropic imaging agent means it increases the heart rate and increases force of contraction at a dose of 10 microgram/kg of body weight/ min for every 3 mins and we increased the dose to 20 microgram/30 microgram till we achieved 85% of the age predicted heart rate maximum followed by injection of Tc 99 m Sestamibi myocardial perfusion radotracer at least 2 min before the end of Dobutamine dose followed by usual myocardial perfusion acquisition under dual head SPECT Gamma camera.


This study is being used routinely for the ist time here in Aurobindo hospital as well as in whole of Indore as well as in whole of Madhya Pradesh on the auspicious day of Makar Sankranti.

The images are of on IV Dobutamine myocardial perfusion followed by resting images to detect the presence of CAD and the future treatment planning.

Case Report -Department of ENT

TITLE – REMOVAL OF A RARE FOREIGN BODY IN SECONDARY BRONCHUS
AUTHORS- DR.SHUBHAMBHATIA, DR PRAVEEN SURANA, DR. V. R MUNJAL

CHIEF COMPLAINTS – An 8-year-old 1 st born male child resident of Ratlam presented in emergency with chief complaint of inhalation of foreign body 1 day back.

HISTORY OF PRESENTING COMPLAINT—As per the history given by the mother, the child was apparently alright 1 day back then she accidently inhaled a broken whistle which was noticed by mother. There was history of cough, difficulty in breathing and whistling sound on forceful expiration.

CT-NECK WITH CHEST - A 7 mm (CC) size hyperdense cylindrical structure possibly foreign body is seen in the distal right secondary bronchus, approx. 2.5 cm distal to the carina and causing partial obstruction leading to air trapping in right lower lobe, showing differential hypo attenuation as compared to rest of right upper, middle lobe and left lung field. No other significant abnormality is seen in CT Scan chest and neck.

DIAGNOSIS – Non vegetative foreign Body in Right Secondary Bronchus

PLAN-Rigid Bronchoscopic Foreign Body Removal by optical forceps

High risk consent, consent for post operative ICU/Ventilator consent were also taken; and after PAC clearance, patient was taken for surgery.

ANAESTHESIA – Sedation

SURGICAL TECHNIQUE -Patient was kept supine and sedation was achieved. Macintosh laryngoscope was introduced in the oral cavity under vision and rigid bronchoscope (size -3.5) was introduced into the trachea. Using optical forceps, carina visualized; foreign body visualized at secondary bronchus at it's distal end. Two attempts were taken to remove the foreign body in 2 pieces, followed by check endoscopy to rule out any other foreign body piece and thick mucopus suctioned out.



POST OPERATIVE CARE

The patient was kept in pediatric ICU under observation for 1 day with intravenous antibiotics to avoid any pulmonary infection and strict oxygen saturation monitoring. Nebulization with budesonide and asthalin was given along with chest physiotherapy.

SUMMARY

A foreign body aspirated into air passage can lodge in the larynx, trachea, or bronchi. Site of lodgment would depend on the size, shape, and nature of the foreign body. A large foreign body is unable to pass through the glottis, will lodge in the sub glottis area while the smaller one will pass down the larynx into trachea or bronchi. Foreign bodies with sharp points e.g., pins, needles, fish bones, etc. can stick anywhere in the larynx or tracheobronchial tree. Children present a higher risk of foreign body aspiration, which is attributed to several factors, tendency to put objects in their mouth, absence of molars to chew some types of food, to cry, walk and run with objects inside their mouth, lack of coordinating mechanism of swallowing, associated to elevation of the larynx and to protect reflex, which is immature in small children. In adults, foreign bodies are aspirated during coma, deep sleep, or alcohol intoxication. Loose teeth or denture may be aspirated during anesthesia. The most common signs and symptoms of foreign body aspiration are choking, coughing, wheezing, and decreasing of breath sounds. Tracheal and bronchial foreign bodies can be removed by conventional rigid bronchoscopy, rigid bronchoscopy with telescopic aid with full preparation and under general anesthesia.


