Happy Birthday to Our Respected Chancellor Dr. Manjushree Bhandari 26th Jan. 2026

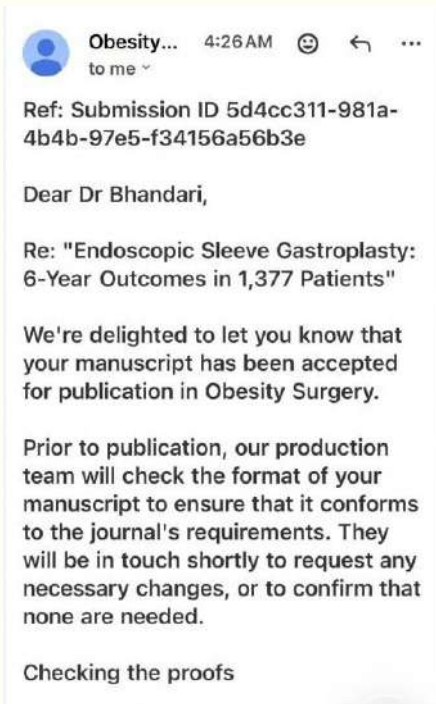

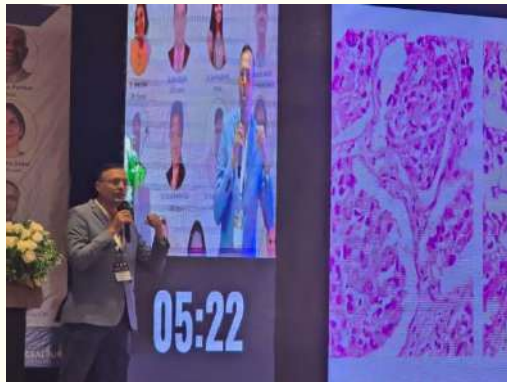
Ist Paediatrics Flexible Bronchoscopy
