NATIONAL SYMPOSIUM ON "VIOLENCE AGAINST HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS"

Under the able guidance of Dr. Praveen Arora, Professor and Head, Department of Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, a national symposium on "Violence against healthcare professionals" was organised under the aegis of Indian Academy of Forensic Medicine (IAFM) on the auspicious occasion of Doctors' Day, 1st July, 2022.

The event was organised in hybrid mode i.e., online as well as offline. The registration was kept free for all. The total registrations crossed the 1000 mark convincingly (1046 to be specific!). The online registrations were 736 from across the nation as well from some of the foreign countries viz. Pakistan, Bangladesh, Malaysia and even Russia, making it an international event in true sense. Whereas the offline attendance was of 310 participants including teaching faculty as well as students.

Online speakers included the President of IAFM, Dr. Mukesh Yadav, Principal, R.D. Medical College, Banda, U.P who enlightened us on "Medical Negligence: Challenges and solutions" with well-studied and impeccable references of legal verdicts. Whereas Dr. K. Gireesh, Deputy Dean, SRM Medical College, Chennai elaborated the importance of "Ethics of Doctor Patient communication" in his usual eloquent style.

The session was started with welcome of all the dignitaries and elegant lamp-lighting ceremony. The opening address was by Dr. Vinod Bhandari, Founder Chairman, SAIMS, Indore. He shared his rich experiences both as a practitioner as well as administrator of the hospital sector with plethora of very useful tips for the budding doctors in order to deal with such unpleasant situations in the hospital.

The session was organised to senstise the students about the solutions available for their adult problems, the problems they face everyday, physically, mentally, socially and professionally.

Dr. Isha Singh, paediatrician and adolescent medicine specialist was the guest speaker. She talked about many aspects of adult life, be it nutrition, mental health, physical health. She also talked about how to cope up with daily stress and anxiety. At this tender age, with very little maturity, girls and boys face many different problems altogether. They get into some trouble, and to put some cover over it, they create more troubles for themselves. They form bad habits, such as alcohal addiction, smoking, drugs etc. without thinking of consequences in their personel and professional lives. Dr. Isha Singh explained them that every problem has a solution, and they can very easily reach out to their elders, parents or teachers or siblings, whoever they are most comfortable with. If that doesn't work, they can reach out to a psychologist/ counsellor.

Many other strategies were shared with students to get past these hurdles in life. Session was interactive with rampant questioning and answering all throughout.

TITLE: OVARIAN CANCER WITH OSTEOBLASTIC BONE METASTASIS- A RARE CASE REPORT

INTRODUCTION: Ovarian cancer is the seventh most common malignancy among women in developed countries and the second most common gynaecologic cancer (10.9/100,000), but most importantly, it is the leading cause of cancer-related deaths in women (6.5/100,000), as the five-year survival rates are below 49.1%[1]. Metastasis to bones from these tumours is rare (0.1-0.12%)[2]. Radiologically the osteolytic lesions were commonest. The survival after bone metastases of primary ovarian cancer is 33%, 15%, and 8% for one, three and five years, respectively with median survival of 7.5 months (range 6–39 months)[3].

CASE REPORT:




Figure 2: figure showing histopathological examination slide of the biopsy taken from left side fallopian tube.

A 53-year-old post menopausal lady presented with initial complaints of bleeding per vagina and back pain since two months. Magnetic Resonance Imaging(MRI) abdomen and pelvis suggestive of space occupying lesion(SOL) in left adnexa of size 6.6x4.3x5.0cm and in anterior abdominal cavity measuring 2.3x4.1x4.7cm in right iliac fossa region with para-aortic nodal deposits present. Multiple bony lesions suggestive of bony metastasis(figure 1). The biopsy and Immunohistochemistry were suggestive of high grade serous adenocarcinoma(figure 2). She underwent palliative debulking cytoreductive surgery. She received 1 cycle chemotherapy with paclitaxel and carboplatin. On Follow up, the Contrast Enhanced Computer Tomography(CECT) abdomen done was suggestive of residual disease with bony, liver, nodal, pleural and lung metastasis. She was given one cycle chemotherapy with liposomal doxorubicin and zolendronic acid(4mg) and was planned for palliative Radiotherapy to dorso-lumbar spine(3Gy per fraction with total of 30Gy over 10 fraction. She is currently on palliative chemotherapy.




Figure 3: figure showing osteoblastic lesion in the patient's CT scan in axial section.

DISCUSSION: The incidence of distant metastasis in epithelial ovarian cancer is 50% as being reported by a study being done on 255 patients, only 40% of which are symptomatic and rest being examined on autopsy. Dauplat et al. reported that bone metastases occurred in 1.6% from primary ovarian cancer, hence, confirming that bone involvement is rare in ovarian cancer [4]. Spine and pelvis presented a higher incidence of bone metastases than other sites[5]. In the presented case, multiple bony lesions in vertebrae, pelvic bones involving sacrum, bilateral ilium, ischium and pubic bones and right femur in the region of greater trochanter, smaller lesions in left femur and other vertebrae were seen. Radiologically, the osteolytic lesions were commonest but in our case the lesions are osteoblastic(figure 3), which is a rare presentation. Management is done by systemic chemotherapy, radiation therapy, surgery, and bone targeted treatment with the bisphosphonates and denosumab are combined depending on the basis of biology of the disease, extent of the skeletal involvement, and the life expectancy of the patient[6].

Bone metastases from ovarian cancer are least likely to respond to systemic chemotherapy, however, patients will benefit greatly from stabilizing procedures such as radiation or orthopaedic surgery. Radiotherapy is effective in relieving bone pain, preventing impending fractures, and promoting healing in pathologic fractures. In this case 30Gy in 10 fractions were given. Although, there was no histological proof of spread to the vertebra but radiological and evidence was considered sufficient proof of dissemination to the bone. Pain palliation was done as one would do in any metastatic malignancy.

CONCLUSION: The case report is a rare presentation of carcinoma ovary with metastasis to bone. The bone lesions in the presented case are osteoblastic which are even more rarely seen.
