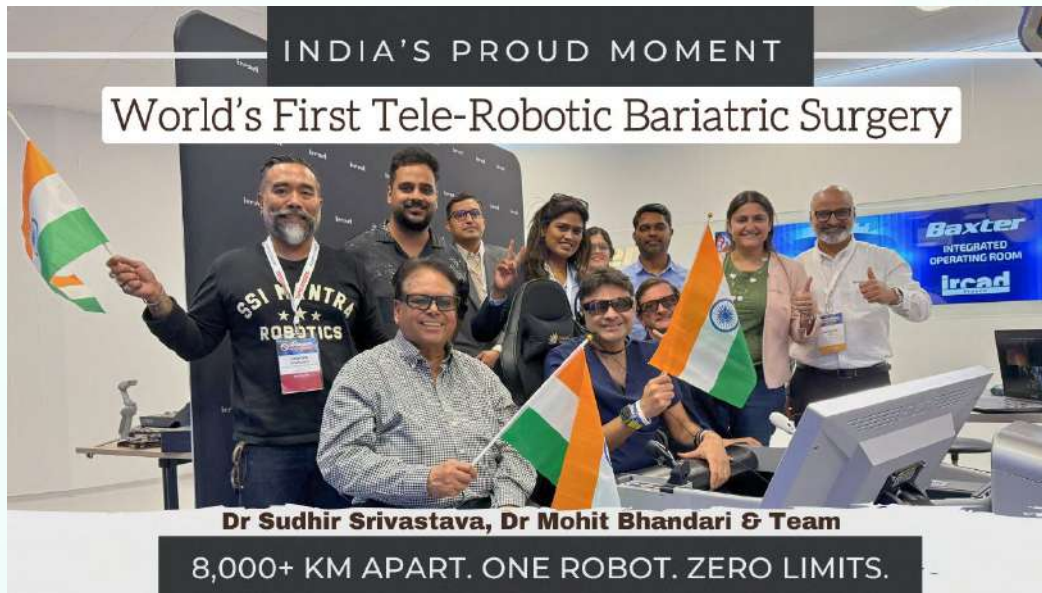

World's 1st Transcontinental Tele-Robotic Surgery by Dr. Mohit Bhandari

Dr. Mohit Bhandari Performs World's First Transcontinental Tele-Robotic Surgery Using SSI Mantra

In a groundbreaking global medical achievement, Dr. Mohit Bhandari has performed the world's first Transcontinental Tele-robotic surgery, operating the SSI Mantra Surgical Robot from IRCAD France. On the other hand, Mohak Bariatrics & Robotics in Indore was where the patient and the robotic system were located. This remarkable feat not only marks a technological breakthrough but also redefines the accessibility of expert surgical care across borders. Powered by Indian innovation, this surgery indicates the endless possibilities of remote, precision-based healthcare.



A Surgical Bridge Between Continents

From a high-tech console at IRCAD France, Dr. Mohit Bhandari remotely controlled the SSI Mantra robot, installed at Mohak Bariatric and Robotics, Indore, to perform a complex gastric bypass surgery with precision, stability, and complete patient safety. This is the first time in medical history that a robotic surgery has been successfully conducted across continents using a system developed in India.

A Historic Moment at IMAS 2025

Dr. Mahak Bhandari perform World's 1st Tele-Robotic Hernia Surgery

In a historic medical break-through, world-renowned robotic surgeon and managing director of Sri Aurobindo Institute of Medical Sciences (SAIMS). Dr Mahak Bhandari. has achieved a feat, that no other surgeon in the world has accomplished before. He has become the first surgeon globally to successfully perform a tele-robotic hernia surgery. marking a monumental moment in medical history. Until now. there has been no official record of hernia surgery conducted through a tele-surgical robotic system.



Dr Bhandari's accomplishment not only sets a global precedent but also opens the door to revolutionary advances in remote surgical procedures. Over 30 eminent doctors, surgeons, and experts from various countries witnessed this groundbreaking surgery live and praised Dr Bhandari's unprecedented achievement

Speaking about this historic moment, Dr Bhandari shared that the procedure was performed from the IRCARD India Centre in Indore, while the patient was located at Mohak Hi-Tech Hospital. The operation lasted approximately 50 minutes and was executed with the coordinated effort of highly skilled technical and medical teams at both locations. The patient has now made a full recovery and has been discharged.

Dr Bhandari said that tele-robotic surgery has the potential to revolutionise access to advanced medical care. Patients in remote regions, often unable to travel to metro cities for treatment, can now benefit from worldclass surgical expertise without leaving their local hospitals. Dr Mahak Bhandari credits his achievement to a fully focused approach, strong team collaboration, and the visionary leadership of Dr Vinod Bhandari, founder chairman of SAIMS, and his elder brother Dr Mohit Bhandari also a pioneer in the field.

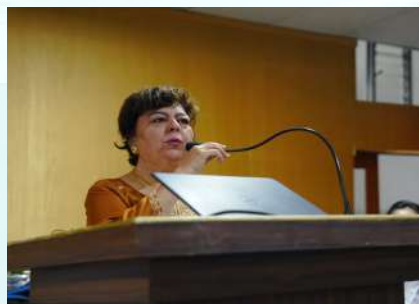
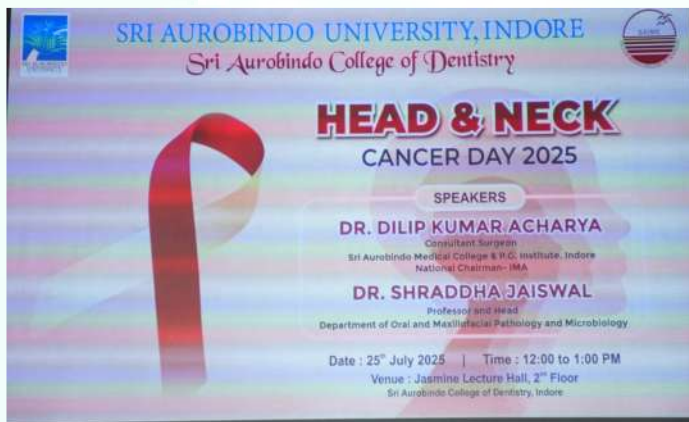

In a unique effort, Sri Aurobindo Hospital has saved the lives of 170 breast cancer patients through its Hospital on Wheels initiative.

Equipped with advanced diagnostic tools, the mobile units have conducted free mammography screenings for over 13k women across nearby areas. Of these, 1,270 were found with lumps and 302 were diagnosed with breast

cancer. So far, 170 have been successfully treated, while others continue receiving care. Sharing this at the free preventive health camp at 1st Battalion, Hospital founder Dr. Vinod Bhandari stressed the importance of early screening. The camp attended by 630 police personnel and families on day one offered free check-ups, specialist consultations and medicines. The three-day drive aims to ensure better health for police forces and their families.
