Operating remotely from IRCAD France, Strasbourg, He successfully performed 10 robotic gastric bypass procedures on patients located at IRCAD India, Indore, using the advanced MEDBOT Toumai Pro Robotic Surgical System.

It demonstrated how robotic innovation, real-time connectivity, and surgical expertise can come together to overcome geographical barriers and redefine the future of healthcare delivery. By performing complex bariatric procedures across continents, he proved that expert surgical care can be delivered beyond traditional boundaries while maintaining precision, safety, and clinical excellence.

What made this milestone particularly significant was its pioneering nature. The successful completion of these transcontinental robotic bariatric procedures marked a major advancement in the field of telesurgery and showcased possibilities that were once considered unattainable.

Connecting Strasbourg, France, and Indore, India, in real time, this initiative reinforced the belief that distance should never limit access to specialized surgical expertise.

He conveyed deep gratefulness to Prof. Jacques Marescaux, President of IRCAD Global, whose vision and leadership have continuously driven innovation in minimally invasive and robotic surgery. He also extended his sincere appreciation to the teams at IRCAD France, IRCAD India, and Mohak Bariatrics & Robotics for their unwavering dedication, collaboration, and commitment to excellence. He was honoured to have Dr. Manoel Galvão Neto and Dr. Mahak Bhandari present at IRCAD India during this historic initiative, further strengthening the spirit of international collaboration and knowledge exchange that made this achievement possible.

Adding further significance to this accomplishment, the achievement was officially recognized by the World Book of Records, London, for performing the highest number of transcontinental tele-robotic gastric bypass surgeries by a surgeon in a single session. Completing 10 robotic gastric bypass procedures within 11 hours established a new benchmark in global robotic bariatric surgery.

This milestone stands as a powerful testament to how innovation, collaboration, and technology can connect continents, transform patient care, and shape the future of global surgery.

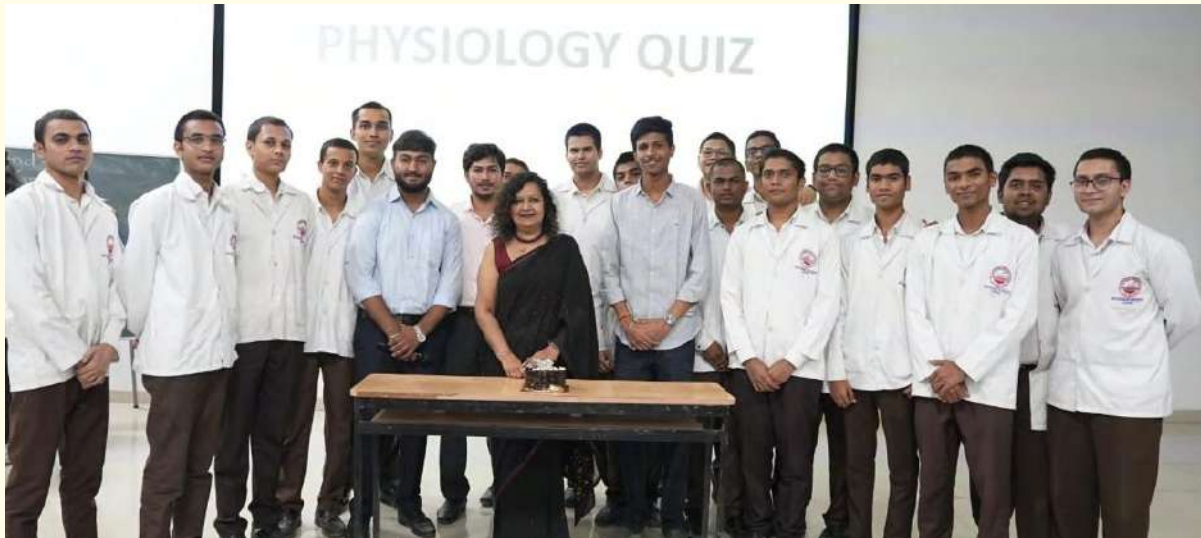

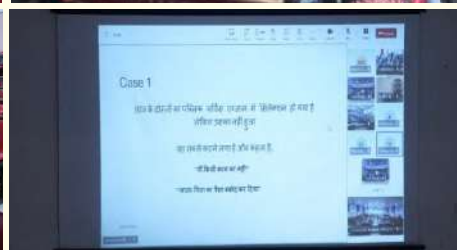


Sri Aurobindo University Conducts

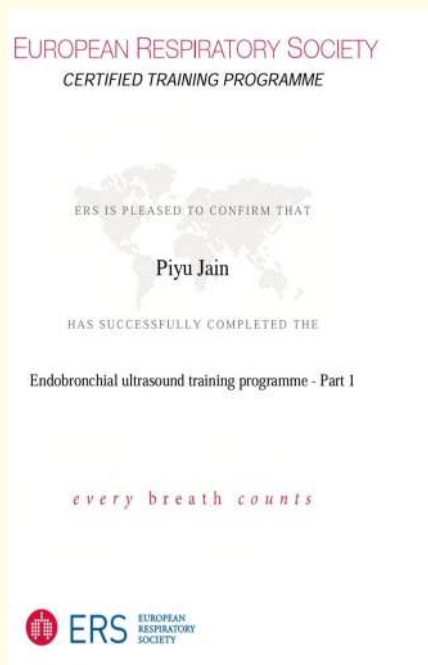

New limbs, new life for six-year-old

Total femur replacement surgery saves bone cancer patient's leg

Doctors at Sri Aurobindo Hospital have successfully performed a rare total femur replacement on a 40-year-old bone cancer patient, preserving both his leg and his life in what is believed to be one of the first such procedures in Madhya Pradesh and Central India.

The complex seven-hour limb salvage surgery was carried out by orthopaedic oncologist Dr. Devendra Nayak and his team. Instead of resorting to amputation, which is often the only option in advanced bone cancer cases, surgeons removed the patient's entire cancer-affected thigh bone (femur) and replaced it with an artificial implant. The hip and knee joints were also reconstructed during the procedure.

According to hospital officials, the patient, a resident of Raipur near Bhopal, had been suffering from persistent pain and swelling in his thigh for nearly two years. After unsuccessful treatment at other hospitals, he approached Sri Aurobindo Hospital, where detailed investigations diagnosed

him with chondrosarcoma, a rare form of bone cancer affecting the entire femur.

SAMS founder chairman Dr. Vinod Bhandari said the surgery marks a significant milestone in orthopaedic oncology, offering new hope to patients who would otherwise face limb amputation. The patient is currently in stable condition and recovering well under medical supervision.

Head of the Orthopaedics Department Dr. Pradeep

Choudhary said timely diagnosis, accurate assessment and advanced surgical techniques can help save limbs in many cases of bone cancer. He added that the hospital continues to provide world-class treatment for complex medical conditions through specialised expertise and modern infrastructure.

Notably, the entire treatment, including the highly specialised surgery, was provided free of cost under the Ayushman Bharat scheme, making advanced cancer care accessible to the patient without financial burden. The successful procedure is expected to encourage wider adoption of limb salvage surgery for selected bone cancer patients in the region.

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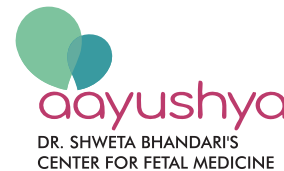
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
