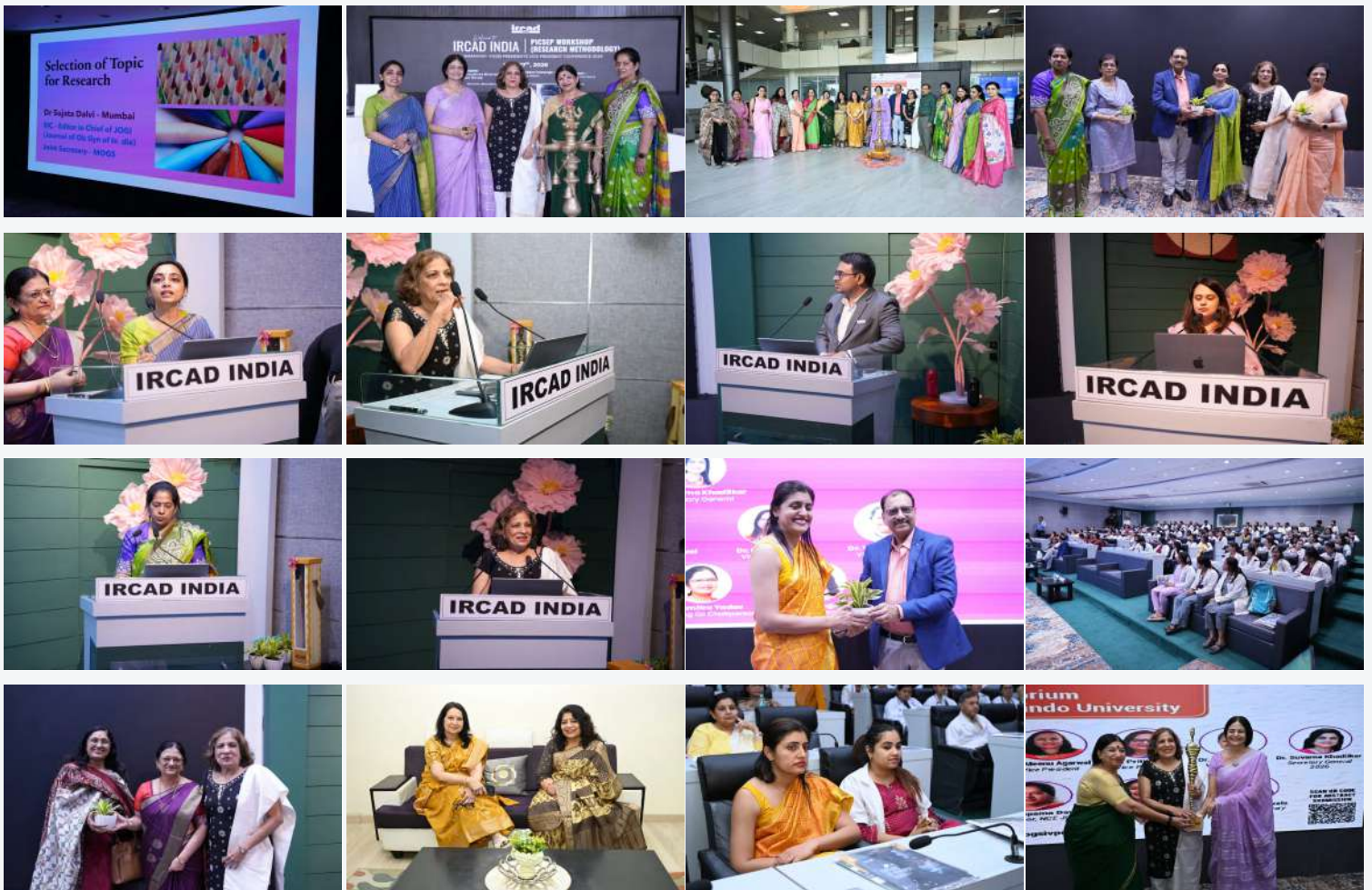
FOGSI JOGI PICSEP 2026

Sri Aurobindo College of Dentistry 15-Day Anti-Tobacco Campaign in Indore

The Department of Public Health Dentistry and Tobacco Cessation Centre at Sri Aurobindo College of Dentistry recently concluded a comprehensive 15-day public health campaign to mark World No Tobacco Day (WNTD) 2026. Running from May 21 to June 5, the initiative successfully reached 692 beneficiaries across diverse segments of society under the global theme, “Unmasking the Appeal – Countering Nicotine and Tobacco Addiction.”

The extensive campaign combined free oral health screenings, cancer detection, behavioral counselling, and creative community engagement. Dedicated camps were organized at various locations, including the Community Health Centre in Sanwer, Shivalik Parisar in Devguradiya, and Sanjeevani Clinic in Ganesh Nagar, focusing heavily on early detection of oral potentially malignant disorders.

Breaking traditional boundaries, the department extended its outreach to specialized groups:

- **Workplace & Community:** Screened 102 corporate employees at TCS Indore and conducted interactive oral hygiene sessions for 60 children at the Police Line Summer Camp.
- **Vulnerable Populations:** Provided critical health education to pregnant women at Pardeshipura on the dangers of passive smoking, conducted a targeted cessation drive for inmates at the District Jail, and served migrant workers in local slums.
