A Case Report

Fabrication of a Radiation Carrier Prosthesis for Brachytherapy in a Case of Basal Cell Carcinoma using Digital Face Scan.

Case Presentation : A 65-year-old female patient was referred from the Department of Radiation Oncology to the Department of Prosthodontics for the management of a biopsy-confirmed case of BCC on the ala of the nose. The lesion presented as an ulcer, and precise delivery of radiation therapy was crucial to protect the surrounding healthy tissues, particularly the eye.

Diagnostic Findings : The lesion was localized on the ala of the nose, confirmed as BCC through biopsy. Due to the anatomical complexity, a surface mould prosthesis was deemed necessary for accurate radiation delivery.

Treatment Planning and Fabrication : The fabrication of the radiation carrier prosthesis followed a structured, patient-centered approach leveraging advanced technology:

1. Digital Facial Scanning: A Medit i700 scanner was used to create a precise digital scan of the patient's facial anatomy. This approach eliminated patient discomfort associated with conventional impression techniques and ensured high accuracy.

2. 3D Model Printing: A 3D model of the scanned facial structure was printed, serving as the base for prosthesis fabrication.

3. Prosthesis Fabrication: The prosthesis was fabricated using clear acrylic resin on the 3D-printed model. It was designed to cover the affected area completely and fit seamlessly onto the patient's facial contour.

Interdisciplinary Approach : The management of this case involved close collaboration between the Departments of Radiation Oncology and Prosthodontics.



This interdisciplinary effort ensured: Accurate targeting of the carcinoma during radiation therapy.

Protection of healthy tissues and vital structures, such as the eye.

Streamlined workflow, reducing procedural time and enhancing patient comfort.

Discussion : This case highlights the role of digital technology in improving outcomes for patients requiring custom prosthetics. The integration of digital facial scanning and 3D printing allowed for a precise, efficient fabrication process. The interdisciplinary approach ensured the prosthesis met both therapeutic and protective requirements, showcasing the importance of collaborative care in managing complex oncological cases.

Conclusion : The use of a custom radiation carrier prosthesis fabricated using advanced digital technologies and an interdisciplinary approach proved effective in treating Basal Cell Carcinoma of the ala of the nose. This case underscores the importance of adopting innovative methods to enhance patient outcomes.

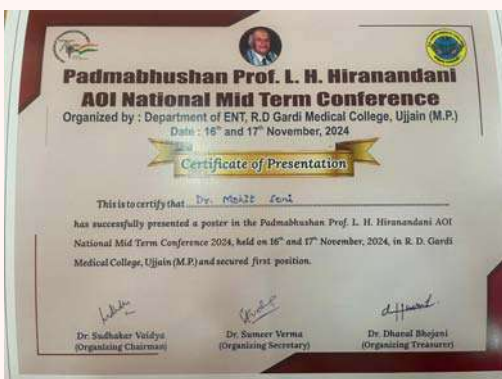
