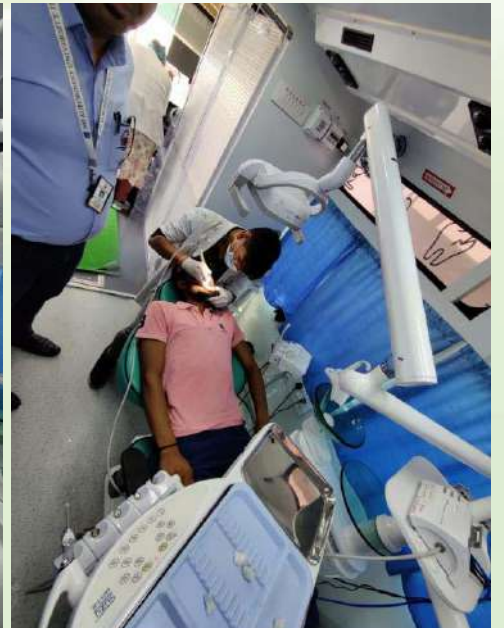

इंदौर | नागदा निवासी सोना पति विजय प्रजापति की गोद में 5 अप्रैल को 3 बच्चों की किलकारियाँ एक साथ गूँजी, तो खुशियाँ चहक उठीं। मगर करीब 6 महीने के तीनों प्री-मैच्योर नवजात शिशुओं का वजन बहुत कम (लगभग 700, 900 और 1000 ग्राम) था। जिसके चलते तीनों बेहद कमजोर थे। वो न

तो फीड कर पा रहे थे और न ही ठीक से सांस ले पा रहे थे। उनकी आँखें, लंग्स और ब्रेन जैसे अंग भी सामान्य रूप से काम नहीं कर रहे थे। उन्हें सीवियर ब्लड इन्फेक्शन भी था। इसलिए नागदा से इन बच्चों को तत्काल इंदौर के श्री अरबिंदो हॉस्पिटल में रेफर किया गया। यहाँ पहुँचते ही डॉ. आभा जैन के नेतृत्व में अस्पताल के सभी विभागों ने नवजात शिशुओं को बचाने की हर संभव कोशिश शुरू कर दी। डॉ. विनोद भंडारी ने बताया कि लगभग सवा दो महीने बाद बच्चे ब्रेस्ट फीडिंग और चम्मच से दूध पीने लगे। इस बीच उनकी सांस की दिक्कत समेत आँख एवं मस्तिष्क तथा अन्य अंगों का भी समुचित इलाज किया गया 10 जून को शिशुओं के पूरी तरह स्वस्थ होने के बाद उन्हें डिस्चार्ज कर दिया गया।
