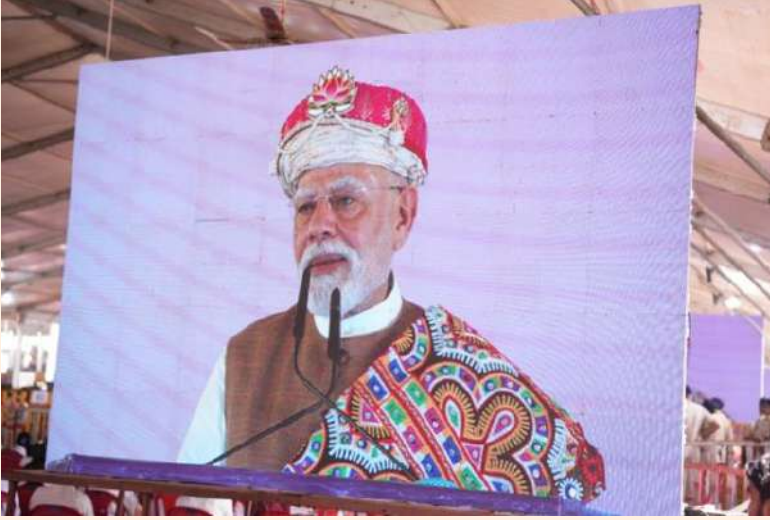

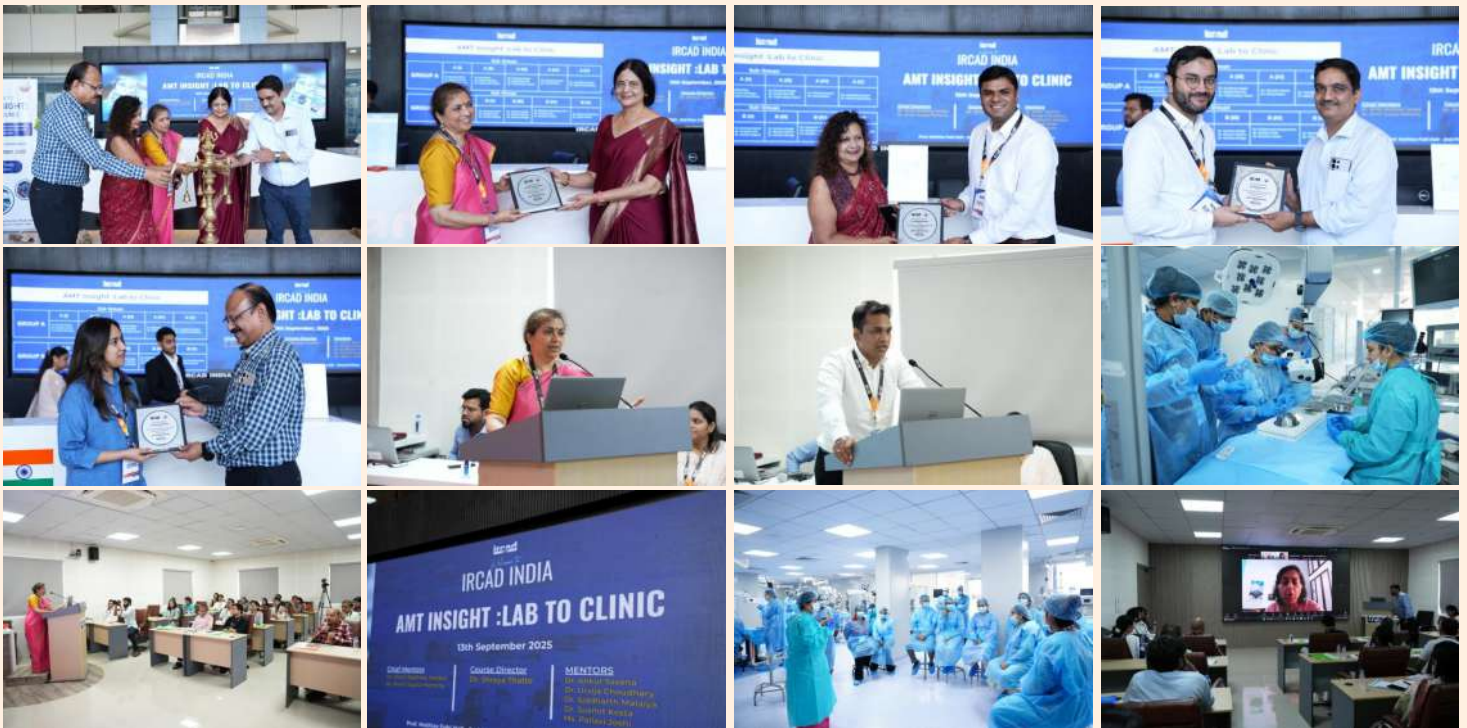

With nearly 300 registered participants, the conference provided a valuable platform for MD biochemists to learn and grow.

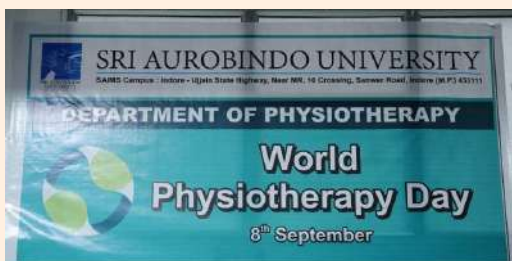

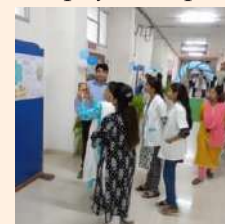

## DEPARTMENT OF ENT

### TITLE- A RARE MIGRATION OF CLAVICULAR KIRSCHNER NAIL (K-NAIL) TURNED INTO FOREIGN BODY OF THE NECK.

**CHIEF COMPLAINT-** A 40-year-old male resident of Dhar district presented to the ENT OPD with chief complaint of cough and pain in left side of neck while coughing for 10 days.

**HISTORY OF PRESENTING COMPLAINT-** The patient was apparently alright 10 days back then he started complaining of left-sided neck pain during cough which was insidious in onset and gradually progressive. There was no history of difficulty in breathing, chest pain, or rapid breathing.

**PAST MEDICAL HISTORY** There is no significant past medical history

**PAST SURGICAL HISTORY** Patient had undergone Kirschner nail (K-nail) fixation for left clavicular fracture which he had experienced in the year 2023 following a road traffic accident.



**EXAMINATION-** The general condition of the patient was fair, afebrile. There was no pallor, no signs of icterus, cyanosis, clubbing, lymphadenopathy, edema,

**Respiratory system-** NAD **Cardiovascular system-** NAD **Neurological examination-** NAD

#### INVESTIGATIONS

On admission, Hemogram revealed Hemoglobin 17.4gm%, PCV 54.3%, WBC 10540 and Platelets 2.29 lacs. Renal function test showed Urea/Creatinine 40/1.12 mg/dL and Electrolytes: Na/K/Cl – 140/4.07/105 with rest routine investigations within normal limits.

**X-ray** of the neck was done in antero-posterior and lateral views which showed a metallic nail/K wire noted at the left clavicle, part of this implant approx. 5.2 mm noted 2.7mm away from trachea (Fig. 1)

**CT neck suggestive of:** CT study reveals long linear metallic artefacts in deep neck space, just posterior to left carotid artery and internal jugular vein with its tip reaching lateral to left peri-esophageal region (Fig. 2)

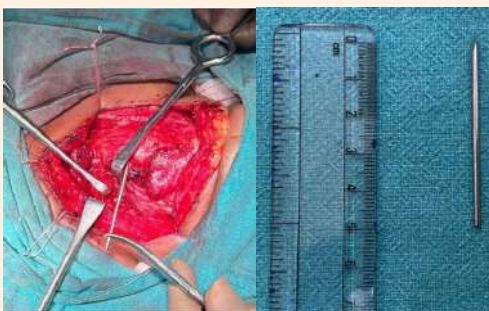
#### **Diagnosis- Foreign Body of Left Deep Neck Space**

**PLAN- C- Arm guided- foreign body removal via anterior neck exploration under general anesthesia.**

#### **POST-OPERATIVE CARE**

The patient was kept in ICU under observation for 24 hours with intravenous antibiotics coverage to treat the implant site infection.

**FOLLOW UP-** On post operative day 10, sutures were removed with no wound dehiscence.



**SUMMARY-** Kirschner wire fixation is generally done for orthopedic fixation of fractures of shoulder girdle and clavicle. Migration of nails or wires of shoulder/clavicular fracture fixation is a rare but serious complication. A few cases of such migration from the clavicle to surrounding tissues and around cervical spine canal have been reported. Hence, it has been suggested to avoid the use of smooth K-wires in the fixation of clavicular fractures and if used, its timely removal becomes imperative to avoid the potential danger of complications like carotid blow, internal jugular injury and entry into the spinal canal due to migration of the K-wire.
