## फिफ्थ जनरेशन रोबोट्स के साथ श्री अरबिंदो अस्पताल लाखों मरीजों की जान बचाने में सक्षम “श्री ज्योतिरादित्य सिंधिया” अत्याधुनिक समग्र आटोमेटिक रोबोटिक सिस्टम का उद्घाटन



इंदौर । मेडिकल साइंस के क्षेत्र में फिफ्थ जनरेशन रोबोट्स के प्रवेश से श्री अरबिंदो अस्पताल में लाखों मरीजों की जानें बचाने की क्षमता स्थापित हो रही है। दरअसल ये पूरी कवायद मरीजों के लिए ही की जा रही है। इससे उन्हें ज्यादा परफेक्शन के साथ त्वरित इलाज मिलेगा। “यह डॉ. भंडारी दंपति की दूरदर्शिता का ही सुखद परिणाम है कि आज इंदौर में विश्वस्तरीय स्वास्थ्य सेवायें मिल रही हैं। आपने करीब चार दशक पहले जो बीजारोपण किया था वो अब मेडिकल साइंस के कटिंग एज के इस दौर में वटवृक्ष बनकर फलीभूत हो रहा है और जन-जन (जरूरतमंद मरीजों) को शीतल छाया प्रदान कर रहा है।” ये बात अत्याधुनिक क्यूविस समग्र आटोमेटिक रोबोट एवं दा विन्ची रोबोट की लॉन्चिंग के मौके पर कार्यक्रम में मुख्य अतिथि, नागरिक उड्डयन मंत्री श्री ज्योतिरादित्य सिंधिया ने कही।

गुरुवार शाम, डॉ. सीपी तिवारी आडीटोरियम में हुए गरिमामय आयोजन में आपने कहा कि “समाजसेवा का रास्ता अध्यापक (ज्ञानदाता) और चिकित्सक (ज्ञानदाता) ही दिखाते हैं। इस संस्था में दोनों का ही समावेश और संगम है। इसलिये यह संस्था नित्य-निरंतर चहुंमुखी विकास कर रही है और भविष्य में डॉ. मोहित और डॉ. महक भंडारी के संचालन में अंतर्राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर अपना मकाम बनायेगी।”

कोरोना काल में सेवाओं के लिए डॉ. का ऋणी है देश। श्री सिंधिया ने कहा कि “कोविड के दौरान डॉक्टर्स और पैरामेडिकल स्टॉफ ने जिस तरह से अपनी जान दांव पर लगाकर एक-एक मरीज को बचाने की कोशिश की है, उसके लिये देश उनका ऋणी है। मुझे भी कोविड हो गया था, जिसके चलते मैं भी इस बात का गवाह हूँ कि उस दौरान स्वास्थ्यकर्मियों ने कितने विपरीत हालात में अपने फर्ज को अंजाम दिया था।”

इंदौरियों के जच्चे का प्रतीक है श्री अरबिंदो समूह - कार्यक्रम के विशिष्ट अतिथि प्रदेश सरकार के जल संवर्धन मंत्री तुलसीराम सिलावट ने कहा कि “जिस तरह इंदौरी बड़ी से बड़ी चुनौती का मुकाबला पूरे हौसले और हिम्मत से करते हैं, उसी प्रकार श्री अरबिंदो समूह ने भी गरीबों और जरूरतमंदों तक बेहतर से बेहतरीन स्वास्थ्य सेवायें पहुंचाने का स्वप्न देखा और उसे साकार किया। इस लिहाज से ये संस्थान हम इंदौरियों के जच्चे का प्रतीक है। कोरोना काल के शुरुआती दौर में जब मुझे इंदौर का प्रभारी बनाया गया था तब पूरे शहर में मुझे डॉ. भंडारी ने ही आशा की किरण दिखाते हुए आश्वस्त किया था कि हम हर हाल में कोरोना के खिलाफ जंग जीतेगे।

देश भर के डॉक्टरों को सिखाएंगे रोबोटिक सर्जरी - श्री अरबिंदो विश्वविद्यालय की कुलाधिपति डा. मंजूश्री भंडारी ने बताया कि श्री अरबिंदो विश्वविद्यालय मध्य भारत का ऐसा पहला चिकित्सा विश्वविद्यालय है जहाँ इन अत्याधुनिक आटोमेटिक रोबोटिक सिस्टम की सुविधा उपलब्ध कराई जा रही है। फाउंडर चेयरमैन डॉ. विनोद भंडारी ने कहा कि हम इससे शुरुआती ५० आयुष्मान कार्ड धारकों का इलाज निःशुल्क करेंगे। रोबोटिक सर्जरी के क्षेत्र में अपने अनुभव का लाभ पूरे देश के डॉक्टरों को प्रदान करने के लिए हम भारत के तमाम हिस्सों से डॉक्टरों को बुलाकर उन्हें अपने यहाँ ट्रेड करेंगे। प्रतिकुलाधिपति डॉ. मोहित भंडारी ने आश्वस्त किया कि इन रोबोटिक सुविधाओं का फायदा देश के हर हिस्से के गरीब से गरीब मरीज को मिलेगा। प्रतिकुलाधिपति डॉ. महक भंडारी ने श्री अरबिंदो संस्थान की करीब चार दशकों की विकास यात्रा के साथ-साथ भावी योजनाओं पर भी प्रकाश डाला।





हैंड्सऑन एक्सपीरियंस का प्रदर्शन - कार्यक्रम के दौरान रोबोटिक सिस्टम्स पर हैंड्सऑन एक्सपीरियंस का प्रदर्शन भी किया गया। श्री सिंधिया ने स्वयं दोनों रोबोट्स का निरीक्षण और परीक्षण किया। उल्लेखनीय है कि क्यूविस समग्र आटोमेटिक रोबोट का इस्तेमाल हिप एवं घुटना प्रत्यारोपण में तथा दा विन्ची रोबोट का उपयोग गायनिक, किडनी, कैंसर और मोटापे की सर्जरी में किया जायेगा।

कार्यक्रम का अत्यंत सथा हुआ संचालन विवि की कुलपति डॉ. ज्योति बिंदल ने किया, आभार डॉ. जयश्री तापड़िया ने माना। इस अवसर पर क्षेत्र के ओजस्वी नेता राजेश सोनकर, विवि के कुलसचिव डॉ. आनंद मिश्रा, डीन आर.आर. वाबरे समेत अनेक गणमान्यजन, फैकल्टीज, डॉक्टर्स और बड़ी संख्या में स्टूडेंट्स भी मौजूद थे।

## IMLEACON'22 – Event Report

*"The law and medicine should be very serious professions to undertake, should they not? People's lives and fortunes depend on them – George Eliot".*

Law and Medicine are the backbones of society, and the application of Law in Medicine is as essential as they both are, individually. With the notion of cognizing young physicians of the medico-legal and ethical knowledge, IMLEACON'22 was organized on 24<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> December 2022 in the lush campus of Sri Aurobindo University, Indore.

The theme of the event was **"Medical Litigations: A look into the Panacea"**, ably chosen by the organizing members after understanding the current situation of emerging medico-legal litigations against doctors.

### Conference Work Up –

Under the able directions of Dr. Vinod Bhandari, Chairperson, SAIMS, and Dr. Manjushree Bhandari, Chancellor, Sri Aurobindo University, Indore, and with the adroit guidance of Dr. Jyoti Bindal, Vice-Chancellor Sri Aurobindo University, Indore, and the organizing director of the conference, the event was planned systematically with all the committees distributed with their work.

Organizing Secretaries, Dr. Anand Misra, Registrar, Sri Aurobindo University, and Dr. Pooja Reddy, HOD, Pharmacology were keenly attributing their experience in the conference.

The preparation started with the Online Registration process and more than 300 delegates registered for the colloquium. The conference could be attended both Physically and Online, which depicts the digital-savvy contemplative of organizers.



### Conference –

The conference was preceded by a local sightseeing trip to Indore- The Cleanest City of India, on 23rd December 2022.

On 24th December the conference commenced with the registration of delegates from all over the nation. More than **200 delegates** registered to physically attend the colloquium. And more than **110 physicians** were attending it online from various parts of the country.

**The Inauguration Ceremony** organized at the lustrous C.P. Tiwari Auditorium remarked the presence of revered dignitaries and delegates. The chief guest, Hon'ble Justice Arun Kumar Mishra, Chairperson National Human Rights Commission, India lauded the efforts of Sri Aurobindo University & IMLEA, for spreading Medico-Legal and Ethical Awareness amongst practitioners. The guests of Honor, Dr. Manjushree Bhandari, Hon'ble Chancellor, Sri Aurobindo University, and Dr. Satish Tiwari, Founder President, IMLEA applauded the efforts of organizers for this grandiose event.

**Scientific Paper Presentation** was organized, in which Post Graduates and Faculties from every stream of Medicine presented intellectual research papers related







to Medico Legal Issues. Around 35 papers were presented that were highly knowledgeable and collaborative to research.

Three winners from each category were awarded. In faculty paper presentation category Dr. Kamal Malukani from SAMC, Indore won the first prize, second prize was won by Dr. Anurag Gupta from Gwalior and Dr. Shivangi Maru from SAMC, Indore won the third prize. Among postgraduate paper category Dr. Tanvi Choudhary, OBGY won the first prize, followed by Dr. Kunal Mewara, Surgery, second and Dr. Srishti Jha, OBGY, won the third prize. Along with that Poster Presentations on various topics were held. 24 innovative and eloquent posters designed by postgraduate students were thoroughly filled with the knowledge of the subject. In postgraduate poster presentation category Dr. Abhilasha Meena, Surgery won the first prize followed by Dr. Harshita Jain, second and Dr. Rahul Jain, third, both from OBGY.



**Scientific Sessions** on various medico-legal topics delivered by renowned speakers from the medical profession were enlightening. The scientific committee was leaded by Dr. Praveen Arora.

Topics handpicked by experts in the field to deliver medico-legal knowledge to young practitioners and clinicians. Some of the intrusive topics were **Crosspathy practice: Medico-legal aspects, Gurukul Medical Education, Medical Prescription, Record Keeping, Disclosing Bad News**, etc. held at the auditorium of Sri Aurobindo University, attended by intellects of every



stratum of the Medical Profession from Consulting Physicians to prospering Medical Students.

The distinctive feature of the event was the **Quiz-Vakil**, which was fun and innovative yet erudite led by Dr. Prachi Shaw and Moderated by Dr. Ashish Garg. Participated by various delegates, there was an online screening, in which more than 40 delegates competed and the top 9 delegates were selected for the Final Quiz Round held at the Moot Court of Law college. 3 teams namely- Vadi, Prativadi, and Gawah were made. The audience saw some venturesome competition among the teams. The winners Gawah were awarded the trophy by the guests.



A **Moot Court Role-Play** was conducted by the students, based on the Ankur Arora Case, which portrayed the high-tempered court drama along with the demonstration of how court proceedings are done in real scenarios. The students elucidated medical negligence and its consequences through this role-play under the guidance of Prof. Dr. Rajiv Jain, Principal, Sri Aurobindo Institute of Law.

A panel discussion on '**Litigations against Doctors: How to Stay out of It**' was organized. Professionals from different métiers discussed the topic in a thorough and elaborative manner. Clinicians were given tips and tricks to prevent litigations against themselves, the session was moderated by Dr. Manish Nigam, who is a

### Observation of World AIDS Day- 1st December, 2022

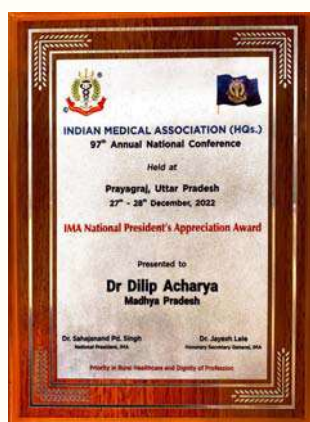

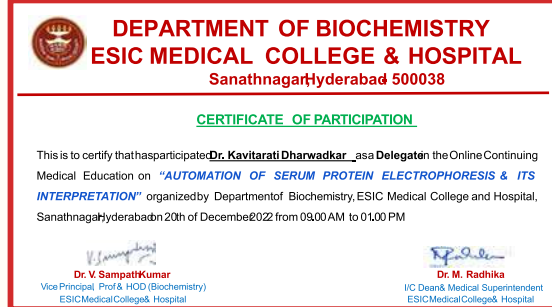

### Department of Public Health Dentistry



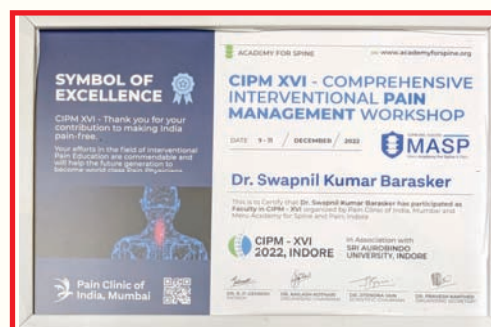
