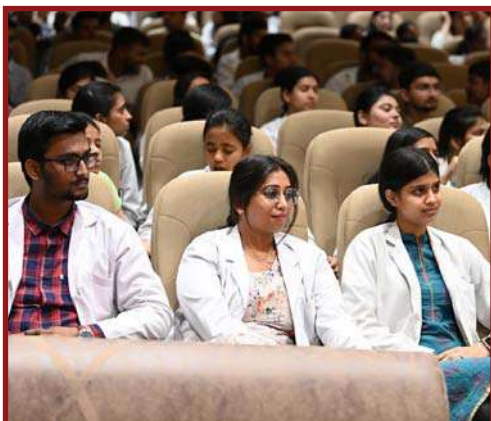

## First Case Report From Department Of Digital Dentistry

A 23 days old male child named Shivaay Purohit (Fig-1) was referred to the **Department of Orthodontics & Dentofacial Orthopedics of Sri Aurobindo College of Dentistry, Indore** from **Department of Pediatrics of SAIMS medical college** with a **Kernahan's and Stark 10,11** cleft palate as the baby's mother was unable to feed her baby and patient was on feeding tube.. The patient is suffering from **Pierre Robin Syndrome**, ie. Glossoptosis, Micrognathia, Cleft palate. The child also has **Atrial Septal Defect**. On clinical examination, we found a cleft gap of 12 mm at hard palate and 10 mm at soft palate. After proper clinical evaluation and diagnosis, it was planned to fabricate a **Digital Feeding Plate for the patient**.

### FEEDING PLATE FABRICATION:

- 1) **Impression making:** Impression of patient was made using light and heavy body elastomeric impression material in NICU of SAIMS Medical College. (Fig-2&3).
- 2) **Scanning :** Extraoral scanning of impression was done using an **In-lab scanner EoS X5** using the (**Dentsply, Germany**). The scan was performed in the **Digital Dentistry department of Sri Aurobindo College of dentistry, Indore** (Fig-4).
- 3) **Virtual setup:** Following the scan, a 3-D model of the maxilla was prepared for fabrication of the feeding plates using a reference point and line grid system that was based on the anatomic structures (Du`rwald & Dannhauer, 2007; Batra et al., 2015).

The setup was exported in STL file format to an **Ackuretta 3-D Printer**, for manufacturing of feeding plate using the EVA Sheet of 1.5mm thickness (Fig-5).

### TREATMENT PLANNING AND FEEDING PLATE DELIVERY:

The treatment will be carried out till hard palate surgery. The feeding plate will be changed in every 1 month to adapt to the increasing growth of maxilla. The parents are advised to keep the feeding plate in the mouth throughout the day and night including feeding and asked to clean the feeding plate twice in a day. The patient will be recalled after every 1 month. The parents were taught the procedure for feeding plate placement and removal & maintenance (Fig-6). The appliance was retained naturally in the mouth (Fig-7,8&9).

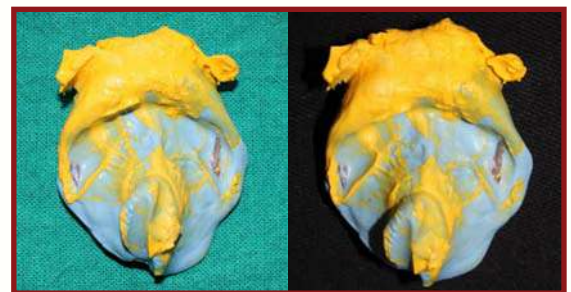


Fig-3: Impression with light and heavy body impression silicon

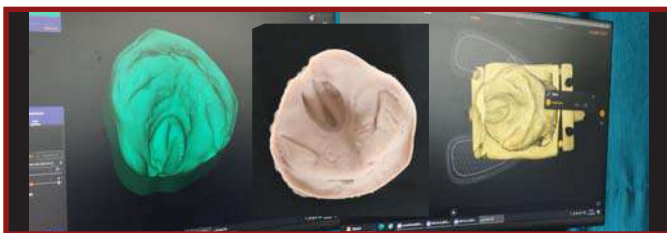


Fig-4: Digital scanning of impression

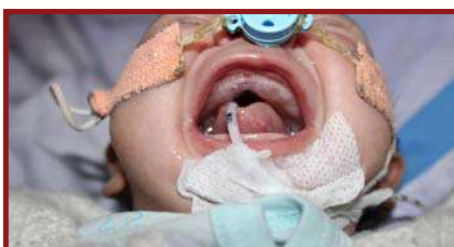


Fig-7: Feeding plate in baby's mouth

## DEPARTMENT OF ORTHOPEDICS BONE BANK

*SAIMS family is proud to present to you the first bone bank organization of all private medical colleges in India approved by the concerned authority. The bone bank was established in 2022. The bone bank is run by the Department of Orthopaedics, SAMC & PGI, Indore. The Bone Bank caters to the Department of Orthopaedics at SAMC & PGI and has on occasion provided allograft for use at other public hospital on demand. The orthopaedic surgeons have used allografts from the bone bank in variety of complex musculoskeletal conditions and published novel techniques and results of use of Bone Allografts. The bone bank department is headed by Dr Pradeep Choudhari (HOD, Dept of Orthopaedics) and is under direct supervision of Dr Neeraj Jain (Assistant Professor, Dept of Orthopaedics)*

*The Bone bank operates from the Orthopedics Operation Theatre at SAMC and PGI, Indore. All grafts are harvested by sterile technique and processed and packaged in operating room itself. The grafts are then stored in -80 degree refrigerator. All the records are maintained in Orthopedic Operation Theatre. Since all grafts are processed as Fresh Frozen, there is no requirement for a Wet and Dry processing room. The grafts are then stored in -80-degree refrigerator.*

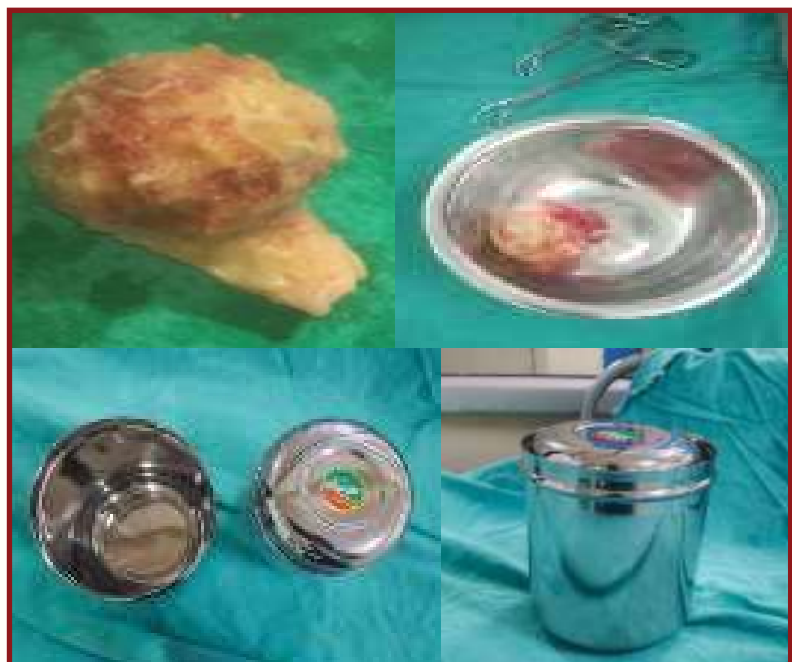
*Processing in OT by repeated thawing, saline wash, Hydrogen peroxide wash, antibiotic wash storage by double container method in deep freezing at -80 degrees or ethylene oxide sterilization in paper layer polythene pack and finally storage for 6 months in deep freezer - 80 degrees.*

*All soft tissues and cartilage are removed from the bone. The bone is then placed in a sterile polyethylene pack and packed in triple layers in sterile pouches. The graft is then labeled and kept in the "Quarantine Section" of the deep freezer at a temperature of -80°C. The culture bottle is sent as soon as possible to the Department of Laboratory Medicine for culture and sensitivity tests for both aerobic and anaerobic organisms. The tissue is also sent for histopathology from the capsule and femoral neck.*

*After 6 months of incubation period this bone graft can be used for bone defect, tumor surgery etc.*

## CONSERVATIVE MANAGEMENT OF HORIZONTAL CROWN FRACTURE – A CASE REPORT

**Case History:** A 37 year old Male Patient Reported to the Department of Conservative Dentistry and Endodontics with a fractured maxillary right central incisor Following trauma and a desire to get it treated in order to have the smile restored. Clinical Examination of the Patient revealed Horizontal Crown Fracture of the right Maxillary Incisor with the exposure of the pulp. (Figure 1)

**Diagnosis:** Radiograph of the Maxillary Anterior Region Illustrate Horizontal Crown Fracture Involving Enamel Dentin and Pulp, diagnosed as Ellis class III fracture. The Fracture line Was Oblique Extending From Coronal Aspect Labially To Gingival Aspect Palatally. The Fragment was Mobile but Still Attached to Soft Tissues. (Figure 2)

**Management:** After discussing the treatment plan, with the Patient the Endodontic Treatment with the Upper Right Central Incisor (11) was Initiated. As the tooth was mobile Interlig fiber splint was used to stabilize the tooth (Figure 3) The Working Length was Determined digitally by using apex locator. The biomechanical preparation was accomplished by using the rotary instruments and the Tooth was Sectionally Obturated With 5 mm of the Apical Gutta Percha, using Ah Plus Sealer (Figure 4). Glass Fiber Post was Used to Retain the fracture fragment. Root Canal was Etched With 37% Phosphoric Acid Gel and Dried With Paper Points and bonding agent was applied and light cured for 20 seconds . The Fibre Post was Luted with Dual Core Resin Cement Inserted into the Canal without applying any Pressure and light cure for 20 Seconds.(Figure 5). The Tooth with Guarded Prognosis was successfully managed in single visit and the patients smile was restored (Figure 6).

Dr. Deepa discussed types of Health Research as Laboratory based and Population based studies. Explained Dimension of Health Research under the headings as Theoretical Research, Applied Research, Preventive Research, Therapeutic Research, Exploratory Research, Confirmatory Research, Implementation Research, Translational Research, Bench based research and bedside Research. Broad scope of Health Research was discussed. Dr. Deepa Raghunath described the challenges in designing and implementation of research studies as Cofounders and Effect Modifier. The lecture was concluded by discussing on "Health Research aims at finding answers or practical solutions at individual and community levels".



## Clinical Research: A Journey Towards Development

The discovery of therapies to treat or prevent diseases and improve global health heavily relies on clinical research. SAMC and PGI are taking part in this development with the beginning of clinical research at the Department of Clinical Pharmacology. Following the institutional ethics committee's clearance, we have begun a project in collaboration with the department of medical oncology. The Central Licensing Authority CDSCO & CTRI has already given their approval for this project. Project will be headed by Dr. Vikas Asati (Principal Investigator) Dr. Rajesh Patidar (Co-PI) from Medical Oncology. It will be co-ordinated by Dr. Kalpana Bharani, Dr. Mahesh Kumar Jain, Dr. Anuja Jha, Dr. Rashmi Mahajan & Dr. Nadeem Khan under the guidance of Dr. Pooja Reddy from the Department of Clinical Pharmacology.

We would like to express gratitude to our founder chairman Dr. Vinod Bhandari for his unwavering support in the establishment of the Department of Clinical Pharmacology. We would constantly strive to improve both society and our patients. We hope that this initiative will enhance the patient's experience and open the door to future pharmacoeconomically advantageous treatment options for our patient.

## ICMR FUNDED PROJECT

*Dr. Pooja Reddy, Professor and Head of Department of Pharmacology has bagged a funded project from the prestigious Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR). The project “Effect of peer-group therapy sessions on medication adherence of patients with Diabetes and Hypertension: A cluster Randomized trial in rural settings of Central India” was accepted as one the National Task Force on Safe and Rational Use of Medicines (SRUM) projects, in which 12 projects were accepted among the 122 projects submitted from various premiere medical institutes of India. The project is expecting an estimated seed fund of Rs. 1.5 crores. The project will be managed by Dr. Pooja Reddy, Dr. Anuja Jha (Assistant Professor, Dept. of Pharmacology) and Dr. Harshal Gupta (Professor, Dept. of Community Medicine). As a part of project refinement, Dr. Pooja Reddy and Dr. Harshal Gupta were also invited to attend the Project Development Workshop conducted at ICMR Headquarter, New Delhi. Department of Pharmacology has always stayed active in Academic Research and this step is expected to boost the morale of the institute. The department is soon planning to bring in a new Clinical Research Wing for running scientific clinical trials.*



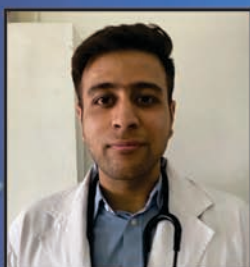
