IRIA MP Indore Branch organized the program on 1 October, 2023 in association with Sri Aurobindo University, SAIMS Radiology Department.

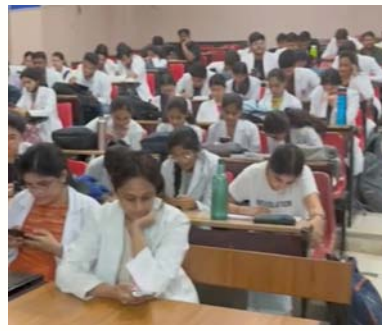

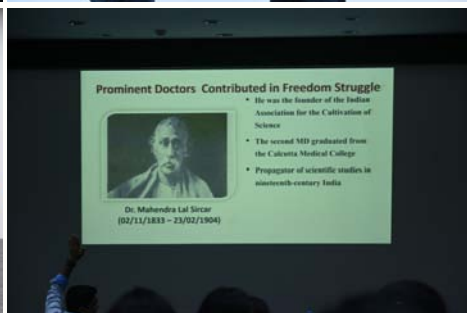


An Enlightening lecture hosted by Sri Aurobindo University

Anti-ragging prize distribution at SAU

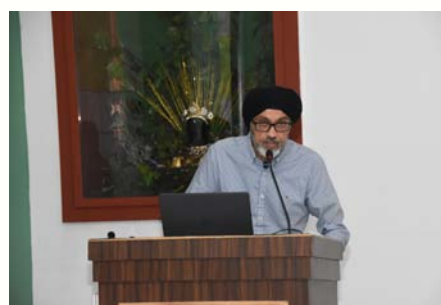

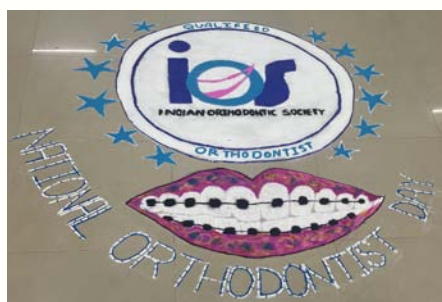

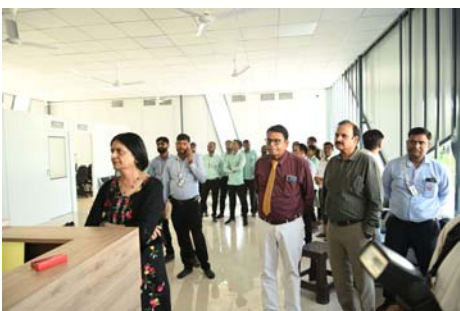
सैम्स में सर्वसुविधायुक्त सुसज्जित ओपीडी का आगाज, शास. कर्मचारियों का होगा त्वरित इलाज

सन् 2000 में भंडारी समूह ने सरकारी कर्मचारियों के इलाज के लिए मध्य प्रदेश में पहली बार सेंट्रल गवर्मेंट हेल्थ स्कीम (सीजीएचएस) की शुरुआत की गई थी। इसके तहत श्री अरबिंदो अस्पताल में अब तक 15 हजार से अधिक मरीजों का इलाज किया जा चुका है। इसी तरह पीएचपीएस, ईएसआईसी और आरबीएस जैसी सरकारी योजनाओं के अंतर्गत भी अस्पताल में बड़ी संख्या में मरीजों का इलाज हो चुका है और यह सिलसिला निरंतर जारी है। इसी तरह मध्य प्रदेश शासकीय कर्मचारियों के इलाज की स्कीम के तहत भी एक हजार से भी अधिक मरीज स्वास्थ्य लाभ ले चुके हैं। हर साल इन योजनाओं के अंतर्गत इलाज कराने वाले हजारों मरीजों की सुविधा के मद्देनजर अब अरबिंदो अस्पताल में एक अलग सर्वसुविधायुक्त सुसज्जित ओपीडी शुरू किया गया है, ताकि सभी केंद्रीय व राज्य सरकार के कर्मचारियों और पुलिस कर्मचारियों-अधिकारियों को अविलंब समुचित चिकित्सकीय मार्गदर्शन प्रदान किया जा सके।

ये जानकारी 31-10-2023 को ओपीडी की ओपनिंग सेरमनी के दौरान अस्पताल के फाउंडर चेयरमैन डॉ. विनोद भंडारी ने दी। उन्होंने कहा कि सरकारी कर्मचारियों के लिए विशेष फ्रंट ऑफिस सुविधा शुरू करने का यह निर्णय उनकी अति व्यस्त दिनचर्या को देखते हुए लिया गया है। ऐसा देखने में आया है कि कई बार वो व्यस्तता के चलते स्वयं एवं परिजन के इलाज के लिए पर्याप्त समय नहीं निकाल पाते हैं। हमारी इस कोशिश से अस्पताल के कुछ रूटीन कार्यों में लगने वाला उनका बहुमूल्य समय बचाया जा सकेगा। कर्मचारियों को कैशलेस और रिएम्बर्समेंट जैसी सुविधायें भी प्रदान की जायेंगी। सैंपल कलेक्शन की सुविधा परदेसीपुरा स्थित श्री अरबिंदो अर्बन हेल्थ सेंटर (भंडारी अस्पताल के पास) भी उपलब्ध है।

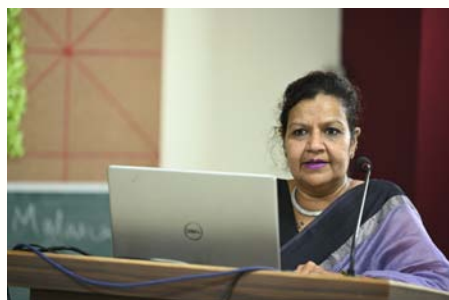
They gathered to attend the lamp lighting ceremony, an important tradition in the academic word and took a sacred oath, emphasizing their commitment to the field of Nursing.

The theme for Mental Health Day this year is “Mental Health is a Universal Human Right”

The SAIMS College of Nursing, observed World Mental Health Day under the guidance of Dr. Prerna Pandey, Principal SAIMS College of Nursing.

A series of three day events were held in community and OPD area, on 12th to 14th Oct. 2023 keeping the theme in mind to improve knowledge, raise awareness and drive actions that promote and protect everyone's mental health as a universal human right.

On First Day, 12/10/23, Poster competition on the theme “Mental Health is a Universal Human Right” was held in SAIMS Hospital OPD area, GNM II Year Students enthusiastically participated in it, total 18 charts were made and presented. Judges for the event was Dr. Hiral Kotadia , Associate Professor , and Dr . Apoorva Tiwari , Assistant Professor , Psychiatry Department , SAIMS Hospital.

On Second day, 13/10/23, A street play was performed by the students in Govt School Bardari the main motto of the event was to raise awareness in community area about the importance of mental health, reduce myths and stigma associated with mental illness in community areas, and to seek a professional consultation in chronic cases. For this two different skits were prepared by students , 1st skit showed the ways of improving mental health and reduce day to day stress in daily life and 2nd skit showed the two bitter truth of society i.e Body shaming and Over expectations of parents in academic scores from the child. The event was a huge success more than 100 school students and local residents of village attended the program. The program ended with a tree plantation leaving a message of ecosystem conservation too.

On Third day, 14/10/23 , The community outreach program in the form of street play was presented in front of Ayushman OPD, SAIMS Hospital from 10.30 am – 12 Noon, to raise awareness surrounding research and treatments, reduce the stigma associated with mental illness, and celebrate recovery from mental illness. Because of misconceptions and stigma surrounding mental health issues, people often suffer in silence and don't seek treatment for their conditions , for this Mental health awareness is an important initiative to improve understanding of mental health conditions and increase access to healthcare for those who need it.

In the Afternoon session, from 2pm – 4pm, A Health talk was also held on the burning issue, which is also a mental health emergency i.e Suicide , in Lavender hall followed by a valedictory session. The session started with Sarasvati Vandana and Lamp lighting by the dignitaries. First talk of the event was taken by Dr. Hiral Kotadia , Associate Professor , Psychiatry Department , SAIMS Hospital , he spoke on the role of psychiatrist in prevention of suicide . He highlighted the types of suicide, warning signs and Hotline governmental suicide helpline no. 2nd talk was taken by Dr. Ajay Sharma , Clinical Psychologist he spoke on new concept of 10 non commandments and gate keepers for preventing suicide . 3rd talk was given by Dr. Saroj Singh , HOD , Mental Health Nursing , SAIMS college of Nursing, she spoke on the role of nurse in preventing suicide. At the last our own Inmate Mr. Vansh Bothrawas acknowledged for the courage he took to come out of the chronic mental condition with proper support and guidance from our Mental Health experts , and now he is leading a initiative to reform mental health in society for this he also launched a website named kishoreswasthya organization.

In the valedictory session , poster presentation winners were awarded. First prize was begged by Maya Sondiya, Raveena Rajput and Gayatri , Abhishek Solanki and Varsha Meena, Second prize was given to Priya Tambe, Priya Kashyap and Shivani Ahirwal.
